CLUB RULES

Bredon Buzzards Junior Rugby Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club in the first instance with the coach or team manager responsible for their age group and if this is not satisfactorily resolved with the Chairman

As a member of Bredon Buzzards you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents and their team mates
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members are provided with a match jersey but must provide all other kit themselves. A full range of kit is available from the kit secretary. Gum shields are compulsory as are safe studs. Aluminium rugby studs are strongly recommended although blades will be accepted if they are considered safe.
- Members must pay all fees promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
